## **CAR SEAT FITTING GUIDE**

## FITTING YOUR CHILD CORRECTLY IN A REAR-FACING CAR SEAT

- 1. Place your child in the car seat with the child's back flat against the car seat.
- 2. Place harness straps over the child's shoulders. Harness straps should lie flat, not twisted, and be placed through the slots located at or below your child's shoulders.
- 3. Buckle the harness and the chest clip and tighten until snug. The harness is snug enough when you cannot pinch any extra material at the shoulder.
  - Bulky clothing or blankets can prevent a snug harness fit. Always buckle the child in the seat first, and then place coats or blankets over the harness.
  - Never add padding under or behind the child unless it is recommended for use by the car seat manufacturer.
- 4. Place chest clip at armpit level. This holds the harness straps in place on the child's chest and shoulders.
- 5. Ensure your car seat is installed at the correct recline per the manufacturer's instructions. This protects the child's airway and will help protect them in the event of a crash.
- 6. Contact your local car seat program for additional education including 1:1 appointments.

Referencing your car seat manual is always best for troubleshooting.
