Call to Order	Called to order by Aimee Wollman Nesseth, Program Coordinator
Challenges/Issues	<p>EMResource</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Aimee received an email from Erika’s Chief Financial officer regarding the Invitation to the COVID-19 Portal. There remain many questions about who is to be reporting this data. Aimee forwarded this to Michelle Seitz and Carolyn Strubel (FEMA). They shared with Commander Wagner at ASPR. He is seeking additional guidance. For now, if hospitals are concerned about this reporting, go ahead and report. Aimee will share additional information as it becomes available. Question: Is it possible to lock the header and list of hospitals when entering data in EMResource. It is very difficult to stay in the right “line” when you can’t view the names of hospitals, and header categories. One person reported a “lag” when trying to update information this morning. Aimee will forward these issues to the appropriate person. <p>PPE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Aimee has been asked by the SEOC to make follow up calls to the organizations who said they have decon equipment and may be willing to help other partners with their PPE decon needs. Industrial hygienists are also going to be calling to help answer questions particularly about the UV light process. <p>Evaluating and Testing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Question was asked regarding getting testing supplies. The process is as follows: The lab that does your testing should go through their regular testing supply chain for additional testing supplies. If they can’t procure them that way, then they should ask their County Emergency Manager to put in a resource request through Web EOC to the State EOC. Question: What about when this crosses State lines? Question: How does this work for systems? Question: Have lab directors been sent information regarding this? Who is their contact person at the State for additional questions? Aimee sent all of these questions to Joe Cordova at the State. Governor’s Press Release regarding testing.
