Challenges/Issues	<p><b>EMResource</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Thank you to everyone who is entering data daily on EMResource! Reminder, the State is uploading information 7 days a week to Federal reporting. So, please be sure someone is entering this data even on the weekends.</li> </ul> <p><b>ASPR Survey:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Thank you to everyone for getting this information back in a timely manner! Aimee has already completed the data upload.</li> </ul> <p>Summary:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As a Region, we have employed all of the listed strategies with the exception of: Setting up the Alternate Care Sites offsite and Leveraging DoD to augment staffing in traditional facilities to maximize facility utilization.</li> <li>• We plan to do all strategies by October 1 except Leveraging the DoD to augment staffing</li> <li>• Top Three Strategies: Purchasing PPE, Increasing the use of telemedicine, Setting up alternative care sites offsite.</li> </ul> <p><b>PPE: No updates</b></p> <p><b>Facility Outbreak and Investigations listed on WI DHS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/outbreaks/index.htm">https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/outbreaks/index.htm</a></li> <li>• This is where you can find a list of active investigations in nursing homes.</li> </ul> <p><b>Evaluating and Testing: Please continue to promote these testing sites!</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Community Testing Site (National Guard) May 15, 1100-1900:</b> Sawyer County and LCO, Hayward</li> <li>• <b>Question:</b> What is the expectation of healthcare systems and hospitals regarding the Health Alert #8 recommendations for testing “asymptomatic” close contacts of confirmed positive cases? Are Public Health departments taking the lead on this testing or are hospitals expected to assist? Aimee and Brittany aren’t sure. Aimee will raise the question with WHA and RWHC. This again, is an important discussion to have with your local health department as we shift to more of a surveillance strategy. Who has the capacity? This will be a difficult thing to accomplish when specimen collection and testing supplies remain limited.</li> <li>• Current priority is nursing home testing of all residents and staff prior to May 31, 2020. This is voluntary. May be hearing more about this in the coming week or so.</li> </ul>
